



Flea Treatment

Client Preparation

Your Greenshield Pest Control technician will require the following interior preparation steps to be completed prior to their arrival to ensure a safe and effective treatment

Pre-Treatment Instructions

Interior

- All people/pets must vacate the unit during service for a minimum of 4 hours post-treatment
- Infants, children under two, pregnant individuals and individuals with underlying health conditions such as heart, kidney, respiratory ailments or allergies must not re-enter for a minimum of 24 hours post-treatment. Consult a physician for any further re-entry requirements.
- Fish tanks/terrariums are to be covered with plastic/sheet/towel prior to treatment
- Do not apply store bought pesticides. Greenshield is required to wait 10 days prior to applying additional pesticides
- Thoroughly vacuum/sweep floors prior to treatment. Dispose of vacuum cleaner bag in an exterior garbage. A flea collar in a vacuum cleaner canister will help kill fleas in the vacuum cleaner.
- Remove all items from floors to ensure that as much floor space as possible is cleared for treatment, including under beds, in closets, cupboards, etc
- All pets must be treated for fleas by a veterinarian prior to our arrival
- Remove and clean or dispose of all pet bedding
- Remove affected pillows, blankets, linens that the pet comes into contact with and launder



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Post-Treatment Instructions

Interior

- Ventilate areas by opening windows for at least 20 minutes following re-entry
- Avoid mopping or carpet cleaning for 30 days post-treatment
- Vacuum daily for 1-2 weeks, disposing of the vacuum cleaner bag or placing a flea collar in the canister each time
- Continue to monitor pets for flea activity. Consult with veterinarian for additional treatment.

Allow 30 days for treatment to take effect. Contact Greenshield Pest Control if fleas are still being seen after 30 days.
